A FOREWORD

There is a praiseworthy ambition on the part of many persons to know about their ancestors, and thus we find many Family Trees and Genealogical Records of the families that came to this country in its early history. This idea came to William Carr Lawrence, of Trenton, New Jersey, in the latter years of his life, and he gave liberally of his time, means and energy, in tracing the early history of his branch of the Lawrence family. As he was of the fourth generation from the Joseph Lawrence who emigrated from England to New Hampshire a few years before the War of the Revolution, and but few records available, it was a difficult and often discouraging undertaking. He had gathered about all that was available when death stilled his hands on November 13, 1919. His widow, Mrs. Ellen K. Lawrence, forwarded his manuscripts and contributing letters to Vilas E. Lawrence, M. D. of Ottawa, Kansas, and he to the writer, Carl F. Lawrence of Claremont, California, for

WILLIAM CARR LAWRENCE, the fourth child of Nathaniel Shepherd and Mary Roberts (McShane) Lawrence, was born in the City of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, May 15, 1855. After completing his studies in the public schools he pursued a two years course in Salem Institute, Salem, New Jersey. He then returned to his native city, Philadelphia, and for two years was employed with the firm of J. P. Lippencott & Co., publishers. Upon his fathers retirement from active business in Philadelphia in 1873, he removed to Mount Holly, New Jersey, and was employed by the State Agency of the Girard Fire and Marine Insurance Company, continuing in their employ until June, 1886. He then removed to Trenton New Jersey, and became secretary of the Standard Fire Insurance Company, of New Jersey, and in 1865,¹ at the death of the President, William Dolten, was elected President. He continued in that capacity until 1919, when he resigned on account of his declining health. Mr. Lawrence and wife were prominent in the social life of Trenton, and he organized and was for years President of the Park Island Canoe Association, and was also a member of the American Canoe Association. On his way to California with his wife in the fall of 1919 he was taken ill and died at a sanitarium at Clifton Springs, New York, November 13, 1919. He was married to Miss Ellen Kirkbride, Sept. 30, 1882, who resides at the family home, 412, Greenwood Avenue, Trenton, New Jersey.

CARL FRANKLIN LAWRENCE, the second son of James Mann and Sarah Chandler Lawrence, was born in Plain Grove township, Lawrence County, Pennsylvania, November 20, 1849. His education was obtained in the public schools, supplemented by a few terms in a private academy. The early years of his life was given to farming, with a side line of civil engineering and land surveying. In the year 1893 he removed with his family to Grove City, Mercer County, Penna. from Plain Grove, and became proprietor and editor of the Grove City Reporter. Sold the newspaper and job printing establishment in 1911, and retired from active business, removing to California in 1913. At that time he was a Director of the First National Bank of Grove City, President of the Building and Loan Association, Trustee of the local Hospital, Treasurer of Woodland Cemetery Association, City Assessor, member of the Republican County Committee, and of the Grove City Masonic Lodge. He had also served as Justice of the Peace for ten

years, Notary Public, School Director, Clerk of the City Council, President of the Commercial Club, and Worshipful Master of the Masonic Lodge. Since removing to California he has been successfully engaged in the culture and shipping of oranges. He was Married September 5, 1871 to Miss Mary A. Barber, and on September 5, 1921 they celebrated their Golden Wedding Anniversary. The family residence is in Claremont, California, corner Eighth Street and Indian Hill Boulevard.

The genealogy of the Lawrence family has been traced back to the early centuries. When the Hon. Abbot Lawrence, of Massachusetts, was Minister to England, 1849-52, appointed by President Taylor, he made a careful and exhaustive search of all available records. The earliest are of one Laurentius, also called St. Lawrence, who was chief Deacon to Sixtus, Bishop of Rome, who suffered martyrdom August 11, A. D. 258, by order of the Prefect of Rome, for adherence to principles antagonistic to the Roman Gods. Some of his descendants emigrated to England, and the records are lost for many centuries. One of the family became Archbishop of Canterbury, and in the time of the crusades, one Robert, accompanied his king, Richard Coeur de Lion, and distinguished himself at the battle of Acre, and was knighted by the king as "Sir Robert of Ashton Hall," and was given landed estates. This was in 1191. From him sprung a large number of descendants. In the sixteen generations following, and authoritively traced, the name John stands at the head of seven generations. The Hon. Abbot Lawrence, mentioned above, descended from John Lawrence, who came over from England early in the sixteenth century. Our immediate ancestor, Joseph Lawrence, was undoubtedly one of that numerous family in England. He emigrated to this country, as nearly can be ascertained about 1772,² and settled in Walpole, New Hampshire. When the War of the Revolution commenced he enlisted and marched with his regiment, the First New Hampshire, to Lake Champlain. At the battle of Ticonderoga, he was wounded and died from the effects of his wound and exposure June 5, 1777. He was buried on Mt Independence, on the Vermont side, a glorious resting place. In a list of officers of the regiment in April, 1776, appears the name of Joseph Lawrence of Walpole, New Hampshire, as Ensign, date of commission November 7, 1776.³ In a return of the officers of the First New Hampshire regiment, commanded by Colonel Joseph Cilley, he appears as Seventh Ensign, appointed April 8, 1776. Kidders history⁴ shows

that the First New Hampshire regiment arrived at Mt. Independence, which is on the Vermont side of Lake Champlain, opposite Fort Ticonderoga, May 21, 1777. In another place in Kidders History he is referred to as Lieutenant Joseph Lawrence, of Walpole. This was the next grade above Ensign, and he must have received the appointment after January 1, 1777.

Joseph Lawrence was probably married before coming to this country, as no record of his marriage can be found. His wife's name was Silence, her surname before marriage not being known. Their children were: Abigail, baptized April 20, 1777, at Walpole, New Hampshire; she evidently died very young. Joseph 2nd., born November ... 1777, after his fathers decease. He was baptized at Walpole, New Hampshire, November 16, 1777. He was a farmer, and being a man of integrity and good character, was highly thought of in the community where he resided. He was the father of twelve children, Their names and the names of their descendants are recorded on the following pages.
